# Pre-Entry Test (PET)-2022

for admission into 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) course for the session 2022-2024

## **General Information:**

This is for information that the youths of the state who are permanent residents of Assam and aspiring to take up teaching as a profession at elementary level may apply to appear in the Pre-Entry Test (PET)-2022 for admission into **2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) course** for the session 2022-2024 beginning from 1st July, 2022 in the NCTE recognised Teacher Education Institutes (TEIs) of the state.

It is to be noted that the acquiring of this diploma by a person will not automatically enable him/her to claim recruitment in elementary schools.

Applications are therefore, invited from the intending candidates having aptitude to serve with dedication as teachers in Elementary Schools for admission into the **2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) course for the session 2022-2024** to be started from 1st July,2022.

Admission will be open for each Teacher Education Institute (i.e. DIET, CTE, Normal school, BTC and Private TEIs). District wise merit list will be prepared and allotment will be made in Teacher Education Institutes (TEIs) in the districts as per merit and availability of seats. In each district there will be reservation of 30% of total seats for candidates having science stream and 70% of total seats for other streams.

## **Course Structure:**

The course will be of 2-years duration consisting of 4 semesters. The curriculum is based on the National Curriculum Framework for Teacher Education, 2005.

## **Eligibility Criteria for admission:**

- i) The candidate must have passed Higher Secondary (HS) [10+2] or its equivalent examination from recognized Boards/Councils with at least 50% marks in aggregate excluding marks secured in the optional/extra/fourth subject.
  - [For candidates belonging to SC/ST(P)/ST(H) category there will be relaxation of 5% of marks in aggregate excluding marks secured in the optional/extra/fourth subject].
  - [candidates who are appearing in Higher Secondary (HS) [10+2] or its equivalent final examination may also apply to appear in the Pre Entry Test (PET)-2022. However they have to submit their Marks details & upload their original/provisional marksheet before the declaration of result of PET-2022 by login to their account through the online application portal https://scertpet.in].
- ii) The candidate must be a permanent resident of Assam.
- The candidate must not be less than 18 years and not more than 34 years as on 1st July, 2022. There will be relaxation by 2 years in upper age for candidates belonging to SC, ST(P) & ST(H) categories.

How to Apply: Candidates can apply online by logging into the portal https://scertpet.in

Application Fees: Rs. 600.00 (Rupees Six Hundred Only) for all categories to be paid online via Internet Banking/Debit Card/Credit Card etc. during online submission of application form.

## **Selection Procedure:**

The candidates will have to appear the Pre-Entry Test (PET)-2022 of 100 marks comprising of 100 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ). District wise Merit list of the candidates will be prepared on the basis of total marks secured by the candidates. Percentage (%) of marks scored in Pre Entry Test (PET) will be added to percentage of marks scored in Higher Secondary (HS) [10+2]) or its equivalent examination for calculating total marks. Same criteria will be followed in case of reserved category candidates also.

## Course Fee:

## (i) For Govt. TEIs i.e. DIET/CTE/Normal School/BTC payable per semester:

Admission fee : Rs.50/- to be paid at the time of admission.

Monthly fee : Rs.50/- per month.

Examination fee : Rs.800/- for each regular semester end evaluation.

: Rs. 100/- per paper for repeaters in semester end

evaluation.

Electricity charges : (i) Rs.35/- per month for the candidates staying in the hostel.

: (ii) Rs.25/- per month for the candidates staying outside.

## (ii) For Private TEIs:-

Total fees as suggested by Director, SCERT, Assam is Rs 27,000/- (Twenty Seven Thousand) only per year. It includes admission, tuition fees etc.

Mode of payment for candidates selected for admission: Will be notified later on.

## **POST ADMISSION CRITERIA:**

- (i) A student who is found absent from classes continuously for 5 (five) working days and students whose attendance is found to be below 80% of total 15 (fifteen) working days from the very first day of class of the session then his/her admission will be cancelled by the concerned Principal and vacancies caused thereof shall be filled up from the waiting lists. However if a student cannot attend classes for his/her health problem in that case he/she will have to intimate the concerned Principal in written form along with medical certificate for consideration.
- (ii) Students whose attendance is below 75% of the total working days of a semester will not be allowed to appear in the semester-end evaluation.
- (iii) Hostel accommodation will be provided free of cost subject to availability of hostels and seats.

  However, the students will have to carry their bedding, bucket, mug, dish, glass, etc. for their personal use. In the event of non-availability of hostel facilities, the candidates will have to arrange their accommodation themselves.
- (iv) Cost of food will have to be borne by the students themselves.
- (v) Breaking of any institutional discipline will be dealt with strictly which may cause disqualification for appearing in the semester-end evaluation/s;
- (vi) If a student fails in certain papers in a semester end evaluation in that case he/she can repeat maximum 3 (three) papers. If a student fails in more than 3(three) papers then he/she will have to appear for the entire papers of the concerned semester. Unsuccessful students of any semester will be given only TWO more chances to clear the concerned semester by appearing together with the next semester-end evaluation.

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO THE CANDIDATES:**

- A) Candidates of the districts where there is no Govt. & Private TEI will be placed in their nearest district provided they will be qualified and they will not prefer other district.
- B) Districts having no Govt. TEIs will not be considered as separate district. For example in Hojai District there is no DIET/CTE/Normal School/BTC. There is only one Private TEI recognised by NCTE. So candidates of Hojai will be included in Nagaon district unless they opt for other district.
- C) After declaration of merit list online counseling may be held subject to availability of seats after closing of admission of candidates from the 1<sup>st</sup> list of selected candidates where candidates will give their preferences of TEI where he/she intends to study. However candidates will be allotted in their preferred TEI based on their total score and category.
- D) In each district 30% of total intake capacity will be reserved for science stream and 70% for other streams. District wise Merit list of candidates for Science & other Streams will be prepared separately as per reservation policy.
- E) Reservation of seats for the candidates belonging to reserved categories including OBC/MOBC,SC,ST(P),ST(H),Person with Disability (PWD) will be as per Reservation Policy.
- F) The following categories of Person with Disability (PWD) will be considered for admission:
  - i. Visually Impaired (VI)
  - ii. Hearing Impaired (HI)
  - iii. Orthopedically Handicapped (OH)

Minimum disability is 40% and not exceeding 80%.

Following Original Documents needs to be produced by the selected candidates for admission at the time of document verification in concerned Teacher Education Institutes (TEIs):

- i. Certificate for proof of age. (Admit Card of H.S.L.C. / equivalent examination)
- ii. Pass Certificate & Mark sheet of Higher Secondary (HS) [10+2] or its equivalent examination.
- iii. Certificate of Caste (if any) from Competent Authority.
- iv. Document to proof that he/she is youth of Assam.
- v. Person With Disability (PWD) certificate (if any) issued from the State Level Medical Board/District Level Medical Board.
- vi. All the selected candidates have to submit an undertaking to the principals of the TEIs in Rs.10/- court fee paper with their signature as follows-:----

"I do here by declared that I have not taken any admission in other regular courses except 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) Course for the session 2022-24. The authority may cancel my candidature immediately with disciplinary action if anyone produce evidence of my engagement in any other regular courses or department in the same academic year and in the event of any information/document being found false or not satisfying any of the stipulated eligibility criteria for the course."

## Filling of OMR SHEET and Marking system:

There will be four sets of Question Booklet (A/B/C/D). Each candidate will have to answer only one Question Booklet. Candidate should note that OMR Answer Sheet shall be used for indicating the answers. The evaluation of OMR sheet will be done with the help of software. No manual evaluation of OMR sheet shall be done. The performance of the candidates shall be evaluated both on the basis of correct and incorrect responses recorded on the OMR sheet. For each correct response 1 (one) mark will be secured by the candidate. There will be negative marking for every incorrect response. For every incorrect response, 0.25 mark shall be deducted from the marks secured by the candidate for correct responses. If more than one response is given to a question then the answer will be treated as incorrect response. While appearing in the test candidates should follow the instructions given in the Question Booklet, OMR sheet & Admit Card and carefully fill up the relevant particulars like Roll No., Question Booklet set (A/B/C/D) etc. Use only **Black or Blue Ball point pen** while filling the choices in OMR Sheet.

Candidates will be required to upload scanned copies of the following documents:

## a) Passport Size Photograph:-

Please pay attention to upload good quality passport size photograph. Poor quality of photograph uploaded will lead to rejection of your application. The admit card will be printed with the photograph you uploaded.

- iii. The maximum file size should be 100 kb (kilo bytes).

### b) Signature: -

- i. Please put your signature with a black or dark blue ink on a white paper.
- ii. The file format should be JPEG.
- iii. Dimension of signature image should be 3.5cm (width) x 2.5cm (height).
- iv. The maximum file size should be 100 kb (kilo bytes).

### c) Other document:-

i.Mark sheet of Higher Secondary (HS) [10+2] or its equivalent examination. The maximum file size should be 450kb (kilo bytes).
